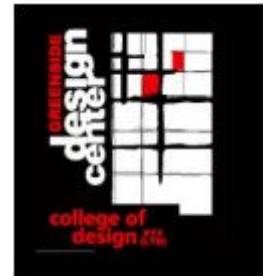
GREEN BUSINESS PLATFORM KLIPSA

Lorraine spoke on our history and our work to a group who are passionate about their region and doing the green thing. Kudos to you!



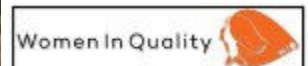
DESIGN COLLEGE GREENSIDE

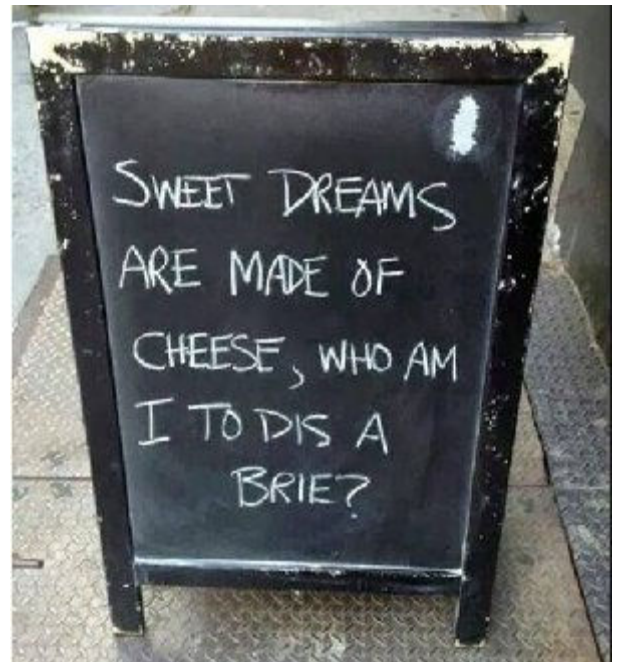
